

These delightful stories are educational and entertaining children's stories that are clever - they educate, help with reading skills and are great fun for children of all ages. Come see the stories!




Crabs Are InCRABable! Is a delightful and funny little story about the crabs we find down under the sea! Why does the ocean roar and shake its white head?





Well, wouldn't we all if we had Crabs in our bed? But don't you worry; I have a really strong hunch,






## That we'll all find our fun Crabs a truly jolly bunch.

Amazing things we will explore, In the Midnight Zone of the ocean floor. Of all the world's incredibly strange sights,






None are as amazing as the Deep-Sea Delights!

Who ever thought EELS could be so much fun? Come, see how Eelectrifying and educational they can be ! If you could see what the Sea reveals,






You would find so many electrifying eels! Eels may look like an ocean snake, But they are fish - so don't make that mistake!





Tickle a squid and I think, You will get covered in sticky ink!




The Cephalopod Octopus likes to play, With little fish that come its way.
